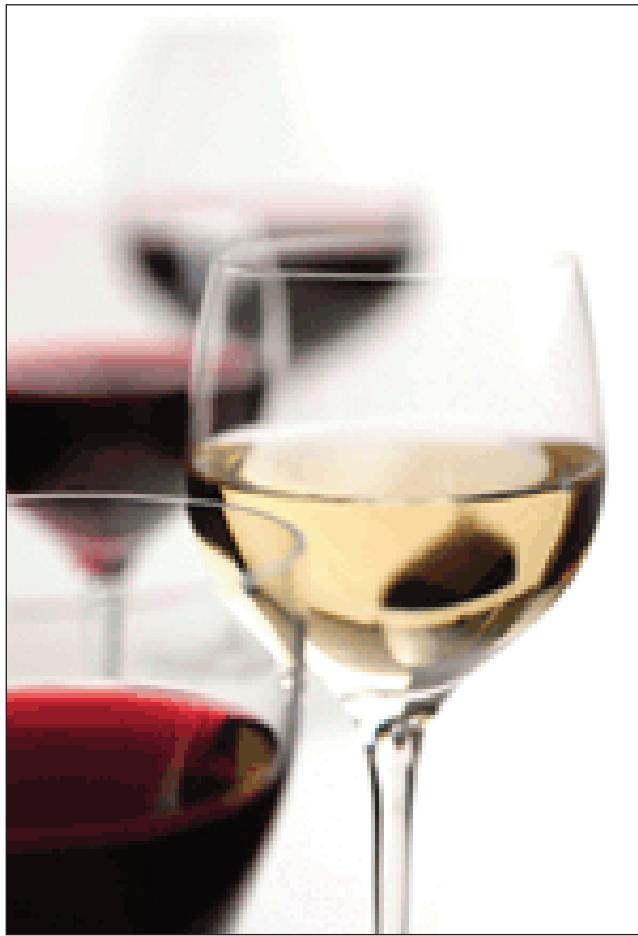

Easy going, soft red with plenty of spicy, peppery fruit, this has good hedgerow berry flavours and power. Shiraz is proving to be a very popular and successful grape variety in the Cape. | £3.95 | £4.95 | £13.95 |
| 4. <i>Vicuña Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot, Valle Central (Chile)</i>

Easy going rosé with attractive strawberry fruit, juicy and fresh, from a modern bodega in the Navarra region of Spain. | £3.95 | £4.95 | £13.95 |

White Wines

6. *Freedom Cross Chardonnay, Coastal Region Franschoek Cellar (South Africa)* £16.95
A complete, lightly oaked Chardonnay coming from the beautiful Franschoek Valley. Lychee and melon flavours are offset by hints of butterscotch, making this a full, satisfying white.
7. *Alto Pampas del Sur Viognier, Mendoza (Argentina)* £17.25
With very ripe, apricot-like Viognier fruit this is full, flavoursome and wrapped in Argentinean sunshine! It is more full-bodied than many European examples.
8. *Amanti del Vino, Pinot Grigio, Terre de Chieti JST (Italy)* £17.50
Crisp, dry and light in body, with fragrant floral tones and subtle honeyed fruit.
9. *Marqués de Cáceres Blanco, Rioja (Spain)* £20.95
Dry but fruity and very well crafted. A thoroughly modern white Rioja.
10. *Brampton Unoaked Chardonnay, Coastal Region 2009 (South Africa)* £23.95
A medley of aromas of poached pears, melon and spice continue into a full flavoured, ripe palate - and not a hint of oak in sight! Brampton is the second label of the historic Rustenberg estate.
11. *C J Pask Omahu Road Sauvignon Blanc, Hawke's Bay (New Zealand)* £26.95
A typical New Zealand Sauvignon with opulent, ripe, tropical fruit and all the classic Sauvignon character one could wish for. This is from a winery on the outskirts of Hastings run by dynamic duo, Chris Pask and Kate Radburn.
12. *Chablis, Domaine des Valery 2009 (France)* £30.25
A classic, feminine wine with an underlying steely quality and aromas of baked bread. Perfect aperitif or with seafood.



Red Wines

13. *Freedom Cross Pinotage, Coastal Region (South Africa)* £16.95
The product of a crossing of Pinot Noir and Cinsault, Pinotage is South Africa's unique grape. This example is softly styled with intense blackberry fruit and mocha coffee notes.
14. *Alto Pampas del Sur Malbec, Mendoza (Argentina)* £17.25
A rich, full red with lovely damson and plum fruits. Soft tannins with a subtle hint of underlying oak. A really great value wine.
15. *Amanti del Vino Primitivo, Salento IGT (Italy)* £17.95
A rich velvety wine from Puglia, the heel of Italy's boot. Full of sun drenched damson fruit, it is soft easy drinking with great character.
16. *Rioja Vega Tempranillo (Spain)* £21.95
A soft, fruity wine with plum and blackcurrant flavours, vibrant and juicy. This is a young (joven) wine without any oak, made to be drunk in its youth to appreciate its lively fruit. From a forward looking winery that has invested a lot of money in recent years.
17. *Tanners Rhône Valley Red, P Perrin (France)* £27.95
A very good Rhône wine which is wonderfully rich and complex with aromas of caramel, spice and pepper. Powerful on the palate with integrated tannin and balance between fruit and acidity. Very good.
18. *Journey's End 'Pastors Blend' (Cab/Shir/Merl), Stellenbosch 2008 (South Africa)* £29.95
An attractive smoky fruit character on the nose, rich and plummy on the palate, this is juicy and very drinkable!
19. *Kate Radburnd Waikarapu Pinot Noir (New Zealand)* £30.25
A succulent fruit filled Pinot with both red and black fruit flavours. It has good body and well balanced acidity. A characterful wine produced by Kate Radburnd from Pask winery.



Rosé Wine

20. *Tanners French Rosé, IGP des Côtes de Gascogne (France)* £16.95
Vibrant colour, intense nose and concentrated palate, this offers bags of ripe red fruit and combines it with lively grass and citrus notes.

Sparkling Wines & Champagne

21. *Tanners Cava Brut, Traditional Method (Spain)* £17.95
Fine and characterful, with aromas and flavours of lime, fruit blossom, biscuit and earth.
22. *Rosè Vino Frizzante, Veneto, Fabio Ceschin (Italy)* £17.95
A charming rosé full of soft raspberry fruit, the palate is light and full of sweet fruit then perfectly balanced with refreshing acidity.
23. *Laurent Perrier Brut L-P (France)* £49.95
Wonderfully open and especially soft, with a beautiful texture and generous fruit throughout.

Dessert Wine

24. *Mitchell Noble Semillon, Clare Valley - Staff (Australia)* £16.50
A great, full-on, late harvest sweetie with a silky texture and excellent balance. Intensely concentrated tropical fruit flavours dance on the mid-palate.
